Forget politics: Bowhill engineers' biggest fabrication

QUESTION: How many wheels does it take to transport the biggest load to leave Bowhill Engineering in recent memory?

Answer: 96.

A truck carrying eight girders -

each 32 metres long and weighing 10 tonnes - travelled from Bowhill to Adelaide on Saturday morning.

The girders will be used in a bridge across the Southern Expressway, which is currently

being widened to accommodate two-way traffic.

Bowhill Engineering managing director Jeremy Hawkes said it was perhaps the biggest load to have left the company's workshop.
